TRACK

Arena Ritten/ Collalbo is an outdoor standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap. The width of each lane is 4 meters with an inside training lane with width of 4 meters. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 26 and 30 meters respectively.

ENTRIES

Entries for this competition will be restricted and must be made according to the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 1690, paragraph 4. Participation is open to Junior A and Junior B Skaters as per ISU Rule 108.

Preliminary entries, giving the number of Competitors, substitutes and the number of coaches and other team staff, as well as provisional names of the Competitors and team leader must be communicated at the latest by **Wednesday January 9, 2012**.

Final entries, including the names of the Competitors and available substitutes, as well as the names of the team leader, coaches and other team staff for whom an accreditation is required must reach the Organizing Committee by letter, fax or electronic mail at the latest by 20:00 local time on **Wednesday January 18, 2012** (see ISU Communication No. 1690 paragraph 4.3).

Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131 as outlined in

ISU Communication No. 1682 need to be strictly observed.

For more details please refer to Rules 115,131 and ISU Communications No. 1690 (or any update of this Communication).

ENTRY QUOTAS & QUALIFYING TIMES

An ISU Member may enter a maximum of 10 competitors per category (10 ladies and 10 men) for an ISU Junior World Cup Competition. Subject of the qualifying times listed below, maximum 5 competitors may be entered for each individual event.

ISU Members entering participants for this Competition, may not enter participants for any of the other ISU Junior World Cup regional competitions 2011/12 to be held in Astana, KAZ and Calgary, CAN.

All entered skater (including substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances, according to the criteria given in ISU Communication No. 1690, paragraph 4.1 as follows:

Junior Ladies:	500 m	44,00
	1000 m	1.28,00
	1500 m	2.18,00
Junior Men:	500m	40,00
	1000 m	1.20,00
	1500m	2.05,00

For a result to be a valid qualifying time, it must have been achieved in the period between July 01, 2010 and the entry deadline indicated in the paragraph "Entries" above.

MASS START EVENT

Mass start races will be organized in accordance with Rule 253, paragraph 4b), with specific rules and adjustments as mentioned in ISU Communication No. 1690, paragraph 5.3. The distances will be 8 laps for Ladies and 12 laps for Men.

GROUPING AND DRAWING

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be according to ISU Communication No. 1690, paragraph 6.3.

POINTS SYSTEM & PRIZES

For each distance Junior World Cup points will be awarded according to the ISU Communication No. 1690, paragraph 7.2, table "A". After each distance there will be an award ceremony for the three best skaters.

ANTI DOPING

Anti doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Code as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communication No. 1650, 1651, 1693 & 1694 or later updates).

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered competitors from January 24, 2012 from 10.00 – 12.00 am / 3.30 – 5.30 pm. Trail starts will take place on Friday, January 27 from 4 pm to 5 pm

LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, the ISU and the organizer assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damages incurred in connection with the ISU Junior World Cup Speed Skating. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

CITIZENSHIP/RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CLAREANCE COMPETITIONS

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 1420 (or any further update of this Communication) all skaters who do not have the nationality of the member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.
