34th Masters' International Speed Skating Allround Games 2026

30th of January until 01st of February 2026
Max Aicher Arena Inzell / Germany

The competition is to be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest, the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) at the 400 m covered standard speed skating track of the Max Aicher Arena (MAA) in Inzell on artificial ice. This competition is a regular event on the International Masters' Competition Calendar of the IMSSC.

1. Distances

Women (all age groups): 500m, 1.000m, 1.500m and 3.000m
Men (age groups 30-60): 500m, 1.500m, 3.000m and 5.000m
Men (age groups 65 and older): 500m, 1.000m, 1.500m and 3.000m

Quartet start may be used for all distances. The D Pattern Regulation 2.1 Masters' Allround Games, of IMSSC Constitution & Regulations will be followed, consisting in the following structure:

Every skater that has completed the first three distances according to IMSSC and ISU rules is allowed to skate the fourth and longest distance.

Limit times

If a skater wishes to participate in Masters' Allround Games, they must meet the following requirements in order to be allowed entry into the competition: a) have a documented time (1500m for MAG, 500m for MSG) on www.speedskatingresults.com, or similar, and; b) have a documented time that meets the Minimum Time Standard (MTS) set forth in IMSSC Regulation 3.2, and; c) have skated that MTS time during the previous two seasons.

If a skater fails to meet requirements a) or b) above they should contact their IMSSC Country Representative. The organizer of the Masters Allround Games and the Board of the IMSSC will decide whether the request will be honored. 3. Participants limitation

The competition is restricted to 220 skaters. The following nations' quota list was defined and confirmed by the IMSSC Members.

4. Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a speed skating license of her/his federation.

5. Drawing, Classification

Drawing for International Masters' Speed Skating Competitions will be done according to ISU Rule 244 for Drawing at International Competitions. For ISU rule 244, paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 apply, as well as ISU Rule 240 paragraph 4, with the following three exceptions:

- On the first three distances all 5 years groups will be joined together for drawing (women and men separately)
- All competitors will be admitted to the last distance
An exception to this is when a competitor has received a Yellow Card from the Referee, the competitor is then excluded from the remainder of the competition (ISU Rule 275 Disqualification)
- The final distance drawing, classification and final ranking will be done in separate 5 years age groups independent of the number of participants per age group. However, skaters in adjacent groups with an odd number of participants, who in this case would skate alone on the last distance, may be paired together on the last distance.

The skater that completes all distances successfully and obtains the lowest total of points in his/her five-year age group wins the four-distance competition in her/his age group.

Seeding

For Masters' International Allround Games, the skaters will be seeded in groups of 6 skaters for the draw, according to their best times of the current season, their best times of last season or their personal best times (and in that order).

6. Prices and Protocol

All participants who skate successfully the four distances contest obtain a certificate. The Places 1, 2 and 3 of each 5-year age group obtain a medal and are awarded a prize. You can view and edit your entry at any time until the entry deadline.

A competitor is obliged to confirm his participation in person before Thursday 29 January 2026 16:00 p.m. If the competitor is not able to confirm in person, he must inform the competition organization via email, phone, or WhatsApp specifying first and last name at the latest 24 hours before the drawing of the competition.

Entry deadline

Generally, entries are accepted in chronological order and the registration is closing **Friday, 02 January 2026**.

The OC is opening for participation of skaters exceeding the National Quotas when the number is less than 220. Registrations will be placed on a waiting list and added to the competition after 02 of January 2026.

10. Registration Fee

The entrance fee is fixed at 165,00 Euro*, this includes a ticket to the admittance to all Official Practice Sessions, Welcome Drink, a ticket to the Closing Banquet, (see under item 7. in schedule). The registration fee must be paid by bank transfer or PayPal to the account as mentioned below. Payment must be made by Monday, January 26th 2025, 1:00 p.m.

Those who have not paid until then will be removed from the start list!

* Subject to change/ if the competition is canceled due to the situation, we will withhold a processing fee of € 5,- per athlete!
