3. COMPETITION

3.1. MUSIC

Every foreign skater shall provide in advance their competition music by emailing an MP3-file to: kt@not-turnhout.be and a copy to music.kbkf@telenet.be

The music must be send in the following format before February 15th 2019.

File name format : *FS or SP* <Category> <Name> <Time>

FS or SP = FS is Free Skating; SP is Short Programm

BNO (Basic Novice) – INO (Intermediate Novice) – ANO (Advanced Novice) - JUN (Junior) - SEN (Senior)

<Name> = name + surname

<Time> = time of your music

example : *FS ANO John Doe 2m34.mp3*

Belgian skaters : Program music will be used from the national database (KBKF Comm 24.2018).

Every skater shall have a CD (no rewritable) with their music as a backup.

3.3 TECHNICAL DATA

The competition consists of
a Short and a Free skating program for Seniors, Juniors and Advanced Novices
a free skating program for Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice

All competitors need to meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements according the latest ISU rules and communications.

Passports of the skaters, must be presented at the accreditation.

The Kempen Trophy is an "Interclub Competition with participation of Skaters from at least two ISU Members" as per Rule 107(14) of the ISU General Regulations. Competitors will be entered by the clubs and will represent the clubs. Competitors therefore do not require any Clearance Certificate or any other permission from their ISU Member for entering the Competition.

3.4. TIME TABLE

3.5. PRIZES

Each competitor will be presented with a trophy.

The results will be published on the internet.

No protocol or trophy will be sent after the competition.

Special prizes will be announced with the provisional time table.

Please use the official entry form in attachment.
State surname and name of participant and date of birth per category. Please be aware that, in case of too many entries, acceptance will be executed consecutively using your sequence.

5.3. LIMITATIONS

The organisation committee will limit the entries. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis; up to the maximum in relation to the available ice.

Following rules will be used:

Every invited club has the right to enter 8 skaters for the category Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice.

They can also enter substitutes for this category. The substitutes will be able to compete if there are not enough competitors for the category concerned or in case of injury from an announced participant. The organising committee will inform the clubs in time in such case. There are no limitations in the other categories.

Clubs subscribing seniors and juniors or boys will take precedence in completing the category Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice.

The organising club has the right to enter more participants.

The organising club will follow the order mentioned on the entry form and there will be no further correspondence about these subscriptions.

In case of a too high number of entries the organisers reserve the right to limit these entries.

6. EXPENSES

6.1. ENTRANCE FEE

Senior, Junior, Advance Novice: 85 € for each skater

Intermediate & Basic Novice: 55 € for each skater

The total amount must be paid within 10 days after receiving an invoice from the organising club, Nieuw Olympia Turnhout.

No refunds will be given

6.2. TRAVEL & LODGING

The organising committee does not pay travel or lodging expenses for the participating skaters.

6.2. SPECTATORS

Entrance fee for spectators: 5 € for the event.

Every skater will receive 2 free event tickets. These tickets will be available at the info desk.

7. JUDGES

7.1. JUDGE PANEL

The participating members may propose a Judge qualified to at least national championship level. Entries from foreign clubs who bring a Judge with them will be preferred in case of too many entries. Names of the candidates should be made available to the organising committee **before January 22th 2019**. Please indicate required hotel accommodation and meals.

7.2. TRAVEL AND LODGING

Travel expenses of proposed foreign Judges will not be reimbursed, but hotel accommodation and meals will be provided for all drawn Judges and Referees starting with breakfast on the first competition day until dinner on the last competition day.

Belgian Judges will receive a compensation for travel as described by the KBKF.

7.3. JUDGE MEETING/DRAWING

Starting order (short program of the categories Senior, Junior, Advance Novice and free program of the categories Intermediate and Basic Novice), will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition. The draw will be published at the info desk and on

The starting order of the free program (advanced novice, junior, senior) will be the revers of the results of the short program.

The judge meeting will be held as mentioned on the timetable.

8. PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

8.1. CEREMONIES OF AWARDING PRIZES

When the final results have been calculated, the winner and then the second and third placed competitors are announced and are called to the winners platform.

The Referee and the representative of the organiser congratulate the prize winners.

8.2. SPECIAL PRIZES

Special prizes will be awarded by the Referees.

9. COACHES

9.1. BADGES

Only named coaches on the entry form will receive a badge for entering the restricted zone.

10. HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Transportation to the ice rink has to be organised by the participant.
Participants have to make reservation themselves with reference to the Kempen Trophy
