REGULATIONS

The ISU World Junior Speed Skating Championships 2023 will be held in accordance with the 2022 Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU), relevant ISU Communications, in particular ISU Communication No. 2514. Participation in the ISU World Junior Speed Skating Championships is open to Junior Skaters who belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 2.b). A Junior is a Skater who has not reached the age of 19 by July 1, 2022 (Rule 108, paragraph 2.b) and has achieved the required qualifying times according to ISU Communication No. 2514.

The Championships will include the following events:

- Women, single distances: 500 meters, 1000 meters, 1500 meters, 3000 meters;
- Men, single distances: 500 meters, 1000 meters, 1500 meters, 5000 meters;
- Women, allround combination: 500, 1500, 1000 and 3000 meters;
- Men, allround combination: 500, 1500, 1000 and 5000 meters;
- Races Women: Mass Start (10 laps), Team Pursuit over 6 laps by national teams of 3 Skaters each and Team Sprint over 3 laps for national teams of 3 Skaters;
- Races Men: Mass Start (10 laps), Team Pursuit over 8 laps by national teams of 3 Skaters each and Team Sprint over 3 laps for national teams of 3 Skaters;

TRACK

Max Aicher Arena is an indoor artificially frozen ice rink with a standard track of 400 meters and inner and outer curves with radii of 25 and 29 meters respectively. The width of the inside training track is 4 meters. In accordance with Rue 228 a protective inflatable padding system will be installed around the track.

TITLE AND AWARDS

The winners of the allround combination are the Skaters with the lowest total of points after 4 distances have been completed (Rule 265, paragraph 2 and 268, paragraph 1). The winner will bear the title: "Women World Junior Allround Speed Skating Champion for 2023" and "World Junior Allround Speed Skating Champion for 2023", respectively and will each be awarded the ISU Championships gold medal. The Skaters placed second

and third in the final classification after 4 distances will be awarded the ISU Championships silver and bronze medals, respectively.

The winners of the distances or races will bear the titles “Women World Junior ___ Speed Skating Champion for 2023” and “Men World Junior ___ Speed Skating Champion for 2023”, respectively, and will be awarded the ISU Championships “gold” medal. The Skaters/Teams placed second and third in the respective distance/races will be awarded the ISU Championships “silver” and “bronze” medals.

See Rule 133, paragraph b).

Prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2516, or any further update of this Communication.

ENTRIES

Each ISU Member may enter maximum 5 Women and 5 Men, for each competition, substitutes can be named among the maximum 5 Competitors entered for the Championships (Rule 208, paragraph 2.6). Only Skaters who have achieved, during the seasons 2021/22 or 2022/23, the qualifying times listed in ISU Communication No. 2514, paragraph 4.2.2, may be entered:

Women	500 m 42,50	1000 m 1.25,00	1500 m 2.12.00	3000 m 4.45,00
Men	500 m 38,50	1000 m 1.16,00	1500 m 1.58,00	5000 m 7.05,00 or 3000 m time of 4.05,00

To compete in the Allround event, the Skater must have been entered for all the four distances above.

To be entered for the Mass Start or for a Team race, a Skater must have achieved any one of the above-mentioned qualifying times. However, for these events an exception may be made for maximum one Skater per ISU Member, if so requested by the ISU Member. Exceptions will only be granted for Skaters who have reached the following qualifying time limits: for Women: 1500 m time of 2.17,00 and for Men: 1500 m time of 2.03,00.

Further details on the entry rules are given in ISU Communication No. 2514.

Entries can **only** be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events available at www.isu.org, section Speed Skating or at <https://ssk-entries.isu.org/> and respecting the following deadlines:

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication 1628 need to be strictly observed.

For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131, 208 and ISU Communications No. 1628 and 1797.

CITIZENSHIP/RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

DRAWING

The drawings will be made in accordance with Rules 239 and 243.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

LIABILITY

In accordance with the ISU General Regulations (Rule 119), the ISU, the Deutsche Eisschnelllauf-Gemeinschaft e.V. and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with this Championship. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

FACE MASKS

No advertising marking is allowed on face masks. Face masks may display one (1) manufacturer trademark/identification of maximum 8 cm². In addition, ISU Member's name and/or abbreviation and/or national flag and/or Skater's name may be displayed on the face mask.

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from *Monday, February 6, 2023 to Wednesday, February 8, 2023 at 09:00 – 12:45 and 15:30 – 17:15. The official training will be open for entered Competitors Thursday, February 9, 2023 at 09:00 – 12:45.* Trial starts will be organized on Thursday, February 9, 2023.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

ISU Members may ask for changes in the training schedule latest by January 27, 2023. Decisions on changes' request will be taken by the Organizing Committee in consultation with the ISU.

BOARD AND LODGING

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for expenses for board and lodging at the official hotel from lunch on Thursday, February 9, 2023, until lunch on Monday, February 13, 2023 (Rule 137 paragraphs 10 and 14) for up to 5 Competitors (Women and Men respectively) and 1 Team leader or coach for each ISU Member. Expenses of other officials (i.e. coaches, other team staff members and accompanying persons) other than those mentioned above, and expenses before or after the period mentioned above, will be at their own expense.

Accommodation requests can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating events.

TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from Monday, February 6, 2023 to Monday, February 13, 2023 from the International Airport Salzburg (AUT) or the railway station Traunstein to Inzell and back. Team officials who do not travel together with their team cannot be guaranteed this transportation service.

The price of transportation from the Salzburg Airport to Inzell is € 25,00 one way and from the Traunstein railway station to Inzell is € 15,00 one way. There is a train connection from Munich Airport through Munich to Traunstein every hour.

A shuttle bus service will be available between the official hotel(s) and the ice-rink from Monday, February 6, 2023.

The distance from the hotel to the ice rink is 1.5 km (15 min. to walk)

The Organizing Committee must be informed via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events about the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitors and officials as soon as possible, but at the latest by January 16, 2023.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

A visitor visa may be required for participants and team officials. Please contact the Deutsche Eisschnelllauf-Gemeinschaft e.V. if you need an invitation letter for the visa. For the invitation letter please submit the following information:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Passport number
- Passport expiration date
- Arrival & Departure date

Please submit all this information to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, in order to have the necessary visas completed in due time.

To facilitate immigration procedures all Event participants (Skaters, Team staff, Officials) need to present a personal invitation letter for the Event on arrival in Germany. Personal information as specified above for Visa application must therefore be submitted to the OC not later than February 5, 2023.
