Quartet starts will be used in the 3000m (it may also be used for 1000 and 1500m) according to ISU Communication No. 2507, paragraph 5.1).

TRACK

A standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at Max Aicher Arena, an artificially frozen indoor skating rink in Inzell. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 25 and 29 meters, respectively. The width of the inside training lane is 4 meters.

ENTRIES

Entries for this competition will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2507, paragraph 4.

As per ISU Rule 108, participation in the **Juniors division** is open to:

- **Juniors A and B** born in the period 1 July 2003 – 30 June 2007;

Participation in the **Neo-seniors division** is open to:

- **Skaters** born in the period 1 July 1999 – 30 June 2003.

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events on www.isu.org, section Speed Skating or <https://ssk-entries.isu.org/> and respecting the following deadlines:

Preliminary entries, giving the estimated number of Competitors and the number of coaches and other team staff, as well as provisional names of the Competitors and Team leader must be communicated at the latest by **January 4, 2023**.

Final entries including the names of the Competitors and available substitutes, as well as the names of the Team leader, coaches and other team staff for whom an accreditation is required must reach the Organizing Committee at the latest by 12:00 noon (local time) on **January 30, 2023**.

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628, need to be strictly observed.

For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communications No. 1628 and 1797 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

ENTRY QUOTAS

An ISU Member¹ may enter a maximum of 8 Competitors per category (8 Women and 8 Men).

Subject to the qualifying times criteria listed below, maximum 3 Competitors may be entered for each individual event, except for the Mass Start event where an ISU Member may enter a maximum of 2 Competitors. For each Division, an ISU Member may enter one team for each of the Team Pursuit events. Only Skaters having scored ISU Junior World Cup points in the Juniors Division during the season 2022/23 and Junior Skaters entered (in preliminary or final entry form) for the ISU World Junior Speed Skating Championships 2020, may be entered for the Juniors Division in the ISU Junior World Cup Final 2022/23, as well as Neo-senior Skaters.

¹ Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

QUALIFYING TIMES

Entered Skaters (including substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances, as listed in ISU Communication No. 2507, paragraph 4.3:

For a result to be a valid as a qualifying time, it must have been achieved in the period between July 1, 2021 and the entry deadline for the ISU Junior World Cup Competition concerned. Documentation (specifying date and venue of the competition) of the achieved time must be available.

MASS START RACES

Mass start races will be organized in accordance with Rule 257, Rule 265, paragraph 6 and ISU Communication No. 2477 (or any further update).

TEAM SPRINT RACES

Team Pursuit races will be skated according to Rule 256, paragraph 2, 265, paragraph 7 and ISU Communication No. 2477 (or any further update), with national teams of 3 Skaters each.

GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be according to ISU Communication No. 2507, paragraph 6.

POINTS

For each distance Junior World Cup points will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2507, paragraph 7.2.

PRIZES

Prizes will be presented to the three (3) best Skaters in each event (distance) in each Division. Junior World Cup points gained will count towards the final ISU Junior World Cup ranking 2022/23.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping tests will be carried out in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures (ISU Communications No. 2344 & 2366 or any further update of these Communications).

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from Friday, February 3, 2023 at 9:00 – 12:45. Trial starts will be organized on Friday, February 3, 2023 at 10:00 – 11:45.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the

official training hours.

LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, the Deutsche Eisschnelllauf-Gemeinschaft e.V. and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the ISU Junior World Cup Speed Skating. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

BOARD AND LODGING

The Organizing Committee will cover room and meal expenses at the official Hotel(s) for up to two (2) Skaters or, alternatively, for one (1) Skater and one (1) Team leader from each participating ISU Member (based on one double room or two single rooms), beginning with dinner on the evening of Friday, February 3, 2023 and ending with breakfast on the morning of Monday, February 6, 2023.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of hotel rooms available to each team at the official hotel(s). The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. Names and functions of all team officials must be submitted together with the final entries for the competition.

TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide the transfer from the International Airport Salzburg (AUT) to Inzell or transfer from the railway station Traunstein to Inzell and back. The price of transportation from the Salzburg Airport to Inzell is € 25,00 one way and from the Traunstein railway station to Inzell is € 15,00 one way. There

is a train connection from Munich Airport through Munich to Traunstein every hour.

The Organizing Committee would like to be informed via the ISU Online Entry System about the time of arrival and departure (incl. flight details) of the competitors and team officials as soon as possible, but not later than Monday, January 16, 2023.

The Organizing Committee will provide Transportation between the official hotel(s) and the ice rink from Friday, February 3, 2023 until the Competition is finished.

The distance from the hotel to the ice rink is 1.5 km (15 min. to walk)

VISA REQUIREMENTS

A visitor visa may be required for participants and team officials. Please contact the Deutsche Eisschnelllauf-Gemeinschaft e.V. if you need an invitation letter for the visa. For the invitation letter please submit the following information:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Passport number
- Passport expiration date
- Arrival & departure date

Please submit all this information to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, in order to have the necessary visas completed in due time.

To facilitate immigration procedures all Event participants (Skaters, Team staff, Officials) need to present a personal invitation letter for the Event on arrival in Germany. Personal information as specified above for Visa application must therefore be submitted to the OC not later than January 29, 2023.
